MAJOR PROGRAMS—TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

LIFE regularly provides technical assistance to various organizations which could entail something as simple as helping to identify & secure speakers and relevant financial educational literature for upcoming events; to more complicated technical assistance such as assisting with operational issues, board training, financial operations, event planning, & marketing.

FAITH-BASED PROGRAMMING:

We have partnered with numerous churches and faith-based organizations all over the country to conduct seminars and workshops; and also to offer technical assistance to them in implementing their programs. For instance, in the Fall of 2015, we assisted the **Reid Senior Center** with identifying and securing speakers for their weekly educational sessions. We also assisted in securing offsite "fall prevention" training at the rehabilitation center of a local physical therapist.



HOUSING EDUCATION AND EVENTS:

Coalition for Homeownership Preservation, Prince Georges County

The Coalition for Homeownership Preservation in Prince George's County was formed in 2007 by public & private sector leaders to address the high number of foreclosures occurring in Prince Georges County. LIFE served on the Coalition's Steering Committee for several years & provided strategic assistance with their marketing and community outreach efforts. We led development of a Coalition Brochure, Coalition Newsletter & Coalition/LIFE Housing & Foreclosure Prevention Resource Directory.
